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Appendix Covid-19 to the Co-responsibility Pact

The **school undertakes to:**

- to carry out the interventions of an organizational nature, within the limits of their competence and with the resources available, in compliance with the current legislation and the guidelines issued by the competent authorities;
- to draw up a distance learning plan in the event of school closure;
- to implement all the best educational and organizational solutions that may include the use of outdoor spaces and the planning of exits on the territory to ensure the school service;
- take all preventive and protective measures to contain the risk of contagion and take measures to manage any Covid-19 cases;
- to provide timely information on any organisational and hygienic-sanitary arrangements adopted to contain the spread of infection by Covid-19 and to communicate any changes or additions to the provisions;
- adopt all hygiene and health requirements, including provisions on distancing;
- employing suitably trained staff on hygiene and health procedures to combat the spread of contagion. The staff itself undertakes to scrupulously observe every sanitary prescription and to go to work only in the absence of any symptoms referable to Covid-19;
- to set up a space in which students can be accommodated in the event of symptoms requiring temporary isolation;
- to adhere strictly and scrupulously, in the case of confirmed infection with Covid-19 by a student or adult attending the institution, to any provision of the local health authority.

The **family or the entity entrusted with** the Covid legislation:

- Declares that it contributes to the development of personal autonomy and the sense of responsibility of its children and to the promotion of good behaviour with regard to measures taken in any field to prevent and combat the spread of the virus;
- undertakes to provide a constant educational action on minors to avoid gatherings, respect safety distances, wash hands and/or make use of the gel, use the mask properly (with nose and mouth covered) and when prescribed, sneeze in disposable paper tissues (which must be provided by the family) or in the crease of the elbow, avoid touching mouth, nose and eyes with your hands;
- is aware that the measures aimed at reducing the possibility of infection, the precautions and safety procedures put in place, maintained with capillary and constant control, during the frequency of service, cannot eliminate the risk of possibility of contagion due to the peculiarity of the activities carried out and the type of users;
- commits to take note of the containment measures currently in force and published by the Institute and] to keep abreast of the school's initiatives in this field;
- is aware that the student can access the school if he is not subject to the quarantine measure or has not tested positive for COVID-19 and undertakes to immediately inform the contact person Covid of any changes in health status to the following e-mail contact referentecovid@arcadia.edu.it or to the number: 3534057717 active from 1pm to 2pm from Monday to Friday;
- is aware that it is their responsibility to measure the temperature and that they must not send to school the student who has body temperature equal to or higher than 37.5 °C or has the following obvious symptoms related to COVID (source: World Health Organization):
 - exhaustion,
 - dry cough,
 - soreness and muscle pain,
 - nasal congestion,
 - sore throat,
 - diarrhea,
 - conjunctivitis,
 - headache,
 - loss of taste or smell,
 - rash or discoloration of toes or hands,
 - breathing difficulties
- undertakes to contact the paediatrician in the event of one or more of the symptoms listed above, and to produce a medical certificate of readmission if the absence is equal to or greater than three days. Without this documentation the student cannot be admitted to school. Those who must be absent for personal reasons and specialist visits/therapies are required to notify the school beforehand and produce justification.
- is aware that he should not send to school the student who in the last 14 days has been in contact with COVID patients or people in precautionary isolation

- Is aware and agrees that the pupil may be subjected to random temperature measurement at the non-contact thermometer inlet and that he or she cannot be admitted to school if his or her body temperature is 37,5 or higher;
- declares to be aware and to accept that, in the event of an outbreak of fever equal to or greater than 37,5 persons. or other symptoms (among those mentioned above), school staff will provide immediate isolation of the child. The family will be immediately notified and is required to pick up the minor as soon as possible. To this end, it is essential to ensure the constant availability of a family member or a delegate during school hours;
- undertakes, in the case described above, to contact the pediatrician for the fulfillment of the case;
- Undertakes to promptly pick up its child from school if the behaviour was not in compliance with the rules against Covid and could be the cause of spread of contagion;
- Undertakes to pick up its child in the event that the school could not ensure appropriate supervision for organisational unforeseen events related to the Covid;
- Is aware that where the number of students in a class does not guarantee the appropriate distance, fewer heterogeneous groups will be set up;
- Is aware that, if necessary, students may attend school in turns;
- Undertakes to conduct interviews with distance teachers, by videoconference, by appointment;
- undertakes to enter the secretariat only by appointment;
- Is aware that only one parent (or one of its representatives) with a mask is allowed access to school premises, if authorised;
- it undertakes to respect entry/exit times and routes, suitably arranged;
- undertakes to equip your child/ a surgical mask or with superior protection. No cloth mask allowed.
- Undertakes not to have their children bring home games to school that could be shared with other classes/sections, but only the teaching materials;
- undertakes not to go to school for trivial reasons. In case of forgetfulness of school material or other personal belongings children and young people can do without;
- undertakes to respect the attached Regulation.

Subject to age, the student/students undertakes to:

- to become aware of and respect the simple rules for preventing and combating the spread of Covid-19 suggested by signage and regulations;
- notify teachers promptly in the event of the onset of symptoms of malaise during school hours to allow the implementation of the safety protocol.

The signing of this agreement commits the Parties to respect it in good faith. From the legal point of view does not free those who sign it from any responsibility in case of failure to comply with the

regulations relating to the containment of the Covid-epidemic19, the ordinary workplace safety regulations and the Guidelines for the safe management of organised social and play opportunities for children and adolescents in Phase 2 of the COVID-19 emergency referred to in Annex No.8 of the DPCM of 17/05/2020 and of the "School Plan 2020/21"

The undersigned are aware that anyone who makes false statements is punished in accordance with the Criminal Code and the special laws on the subject, pursuant to and for the effects of art. 76 D.P.R. n. 445/2000.
